- ? Teen camp is open to all youth ages 13-18. You do not have to be a 4-H member to attend. Invite a friend!
- ? Every county must provide one chaperone for every 10 kids of each gender attending camp. Camp registration forms will not be accepted without adequate supervision lined up!
- ? Please plan your arrival for no earlier than 1pm on the first day and your departure by no earlier than 4pm on the last day of camp—an adult from each county needs to stay until all campers have left camp!
- ? Please Note: The South Dakota 4-H Code of Conduct is enforced at all 4-H camp functions!

What to Bring:

- ? Comfortable clothing for warm and cool weather
- ? Shorts/jeans/t-shirts/sweatshirts
- ? Jacket
- ? 2 pairs of closed toe shoes (tennis shoes)
- ? Rain Coat/umbrella
- ? Sunscreen
- ? Mosquito repellent-non-aerosol
- ? Bedroll or sleeping bag & pillow
- ? Towels/soap/shampoo
- ? Swim wear
- ? The 4-H Camper Information Form available at your local Extension Office, turn it in with this registration form

What Not to Bring:

- ? Snacks of any kind from home. This includes your own pop. Snacks and food in the cabins only attract pesky animals.
- ? Valuables: cell phones, iPods, jewelry, excessive amounts of money, etc. Camp will not be held accountable for these items.
- ? No aerosol item will be allowed such as perfume, cologne, hairspray, mosquito repellent, sunscreen, etc.
