

## Pins and Medals Flow Chart

In a perfect world this is how the pins and medals should be received-this is just an example, there are usually exceptions to every rule, you will need to visit with your leader to find out where you fall in the scheme of things.

Please keep in mind that criteria must be met for most of these medals and that there are some age qualifications that must also be met for some awards. If you miss a year for a Bronze, Silver or Gold you can get it the next year, but you can't get two (a silver and a gold) in one year. You must be enrolled in a particular project the current year to receive a project medal in that project.

1<sup>st</sup> Year-1<sup>st</sup> year pin

2<sup>nd</sup> Year-2<sup>nd</sup> year pin and Bronze Medal

3<sup>rd</sup> Year-Third year pin, Silver Medal, and may start earning project pins for projects that have been completed for three years.

4<sup>th</sup> Year-Fourth year pin, Gold Medal and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, County 4-H Citizenship medal,

5<sup>th</sup> Year-Fifth year pin, and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, may be eligible for County 4-H Leadership medal, may be eligible for County Agriculture, Family & Consumer Sciences or Personal Development medals from this year on, depending upon age-only one medal per year.

6<sup>th</sup> Year-Sixth year pin, and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, may be eligible for County Agriculture, Family & Consumer Sciences or Personal Development medals from this year on, depending upon age-only one medal per year.

7<sup>th</sup> Year-Seventh year pin, and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, may be eligible for County Agriculture, Family & Consumer Sciences or Personal Development medals from this year on, depending upon age-only one medal per year.

8<sup>th</sup> Year-Eighth year pin and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, may be eligible for County Agriculture, Family & Consumer Sciences or Personal Development medals from this year on, depending upon age-only one medal per year.

May start applying for the William Krueger Memorial Conservation Award, the Rueben Hoveland Memorial Overall Conservation Award, the Trask Citizenship Award, Flatt Leadership Award, and Bishop Achievement Award.

9<sup>th</sup> Year-Ninth year pin and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, may be eligible for Key Award depending upon age, may be eligible for County Achievement medal depending upon age.

10<sup>th</sup> Year-Tenth year pin and project pins for projects that have been completed for three years, Graduating Member recognition, may be eligible for Key Award, may be eligible for County Achievement medal, may start applying for Bondurant/Trew Memorial Scholarship and the Helen Walsh Memorial Scholarship.

Club Secretary's Book, Club Community Service Award may be applied for at any age by the club secretary and/or club members.
