Reserve Deputy Sheriff Job Announcement

The Custer County Sheriff's Office is preparing for a new Reserve Academy. Reserve Deputies typically work with full-time deputies in performance of their duties along with working Special Events. Reserves who have passed appropriate training are also allowed to perform patrol duties by themselves with minimal supervision. Reserve Deputies hold the same authority as full-time Deputies while working. While the Reserve Program is a recruitment tool and a stepping-stone for a full-time law enforcement career, it is also ideal for someone with an established career who wants be involved in law enforcement, and to make a positive difference in their community.

Requirements: Must be at least 21 years of age. Candidates must have a high school diploma or GED certificate; pass a comprehensive background investigation, No prior felony or simple assault domestic violence conviction; valid driver's license upon application, an insurable driving history, Law Enforcement Officers Standards and Training Commission Reserve Certificate or ability to obtain within one year from hiring date.

This is a Volunteer, non-paid position. Application period is open until filled.
