4-H Treasurer's Books

Each club will be responsible for turning in your 4-H Treasurer's Book with the audit pages (page 16 & 17) filled out and completed. You must turn this in for IRS purposes. Books are due October 1 to your local County Extension Office. **4-H Members and Leaders**-Don't forget, end of year paperwork will be coming to you soon! Please remember that all paperwork needs to be completed and turned in by the dates set by your county office. 4-H Members-you need to complete your journals and turn them into your leader. You also need to help them by turning in the End of the Year Worksheet-this is where you list your accomplishments and request the project pins and medals that you have earned this year.

Leaders it is up to you to collect the journals from your members then COPY page 9 to turn into the office. All 4-H members are expected to complete their Journal in order to complete their 4-H year. This is a very important record keeping and life skill that will benefit all of your members in the long run, especially when applying for trips and scholarships in the future.
