- 1. Rex Harris, Planning Director, gave an update on the drainage system to the water storage system for the courthouse. The plan is to restore the outlet pipe from the tanks and then run the pipes east to a culvert running in the 5th Street ROW and cross beneath Washington Street to a channel flowing parallel with the new Veteran's Memorial and down to French Creek. This will provide positive year round flow away from the Court House.


