Resolution 2020-09

Resolution authorizing improvement of Section Line Highway

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed in accordance with Custer County Ordinance to improve the section line highway described as follows: Starting at Highway 40 Right of Way heading south approximately 580 ft. between Sections 34 & 35, T2S, R7E, Custer County, South Dakota.

WHEREAS, notice has been provided to the public that a hearing would be held on the petition to include the date, time and location of said hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Custer County has considered the petition and found:

- 1. That the Petition is in the form and contains the information required by ordinance;
- That the Custer County Board of Commissioners has considered the complaints and comments of all parties appearing or filing such comments or complaints of record with the Board and /or Auditor's Office for Custer County; and
- 3. That the improvement of the existing section line highway will be in the public interest and should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Custer County, that William, James & Dee Preston be and is hereby authorized to improve and maintain the existing section line road, known as starting at Highway 40 Right of Way heading South approximately 580 ft. between Sections 34 & 35, T2S, R7E, Custer County, South Dakota.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this grant of authorization is subject to the following:

- 1. Said improvements shall comply with Custer County Road Standards and Specifications.
- 2. That culverts shall be installed along the road to assist in drainage and the location of the said culverts shall first be approved by the Custer County Highway Superintendant.
- 3. That said improvements do not contain the installation or construction of any cattle guards or pasture fence gates.
- 4. That Custer County shall not be obligated to provide any financial support for said improvements and such expense shall be borne by Petitioners/William, James & Dee Preston.
- 5. That the Custer County Highway Superintendent shall be notified in writing at least 15 days prior to the commencement of such work.
