

**Custer County Weed & Pest
Chemical Cost-Share Form (2026)**

The Custer County Weed & Pest Board is offering landowners of Custer County a 50-50 chemical cost-share program to treat state and locally declared noxious weeds on their property. Any private landowner owning land within Custer County is eligible. Herbicides must be applied on property in Custer County. The cost-share program is a 50-50 match up to \$1000 reimbursement per landowner in Custer County (*for example a \$250 receipt for qualified chemicals will receive a \$125 cost-share reimbursement*).

Restrictions:

- Herbicides must be used on noxious weeds in Custer County, SD.
- Herbicides can be applied by the landowner or by a licensed commercial pesticide applicator. Labor, equipment, and PPE costs are not covered.
- Purchases made in 2026 only.
- Exclusions include lawn care herbicides, dicamba, glyphosates (ex. Roundup) and other bare-ground products, preemergents, and chemicals labeled for crops. Contact the office for questions about whether a product is covered by this grant.
- Maximum reimbursements and other conditions apply. See office for details. Limited funding is available. Payments will be made in the order received.
- Itemized receipts and completed grant cost-share form must be turned in by October 31.
- Grant funds are not available for use on row crop applications.
- Sales tax on purchases are not covered by the grant.

Limited amount of funding is available for cost-share reimbursement - payments will be paid in the order they are received provided there is funding available. All documentation must be received by 10/31/2026, but you are encouraged to turn in receipts asap in case funding runs out.
